



Frequently Asked Questions

1. Are all K-12 schools able to participate in the Happy Hands Contest?

Yes. Any K-12 school located within the United States can participate in the Happy Hands Contest.

2. How can I make sure that my school is signed-up for the contest?

To participate in the contest is quite easy. One representative from each school needs to fill out the registration form on the Happy Hand Contest website. After registration is complete, Deb will make sure that you receive all the necessary information as well as drawing templates for the contest.

3. Where do I send the completed entries?

All completed submissions must be mailed back to Deb by November 30, 2017 in order to be included in the selection of finalists. Please mail the submissions to:

4. How are the entries judged?

A committee of judges will evaluate all of the submissions based on visual appeal, overall design, creativity and unique design elements. 10 finalists will be selected from each category: elementary, middle and high school. The top ten finalists in each category will then be placed on the Happy Hands Contest website, where the public will vote for the Grand Prize winner in each category.

5. When will the winners be announced?

The top finalists from each category will be announced on the Happy Hands Contest website by February 1, 2018. Once the top 10 finalists have been announced, the public will have until March 1, 2018 to vote for the Grand Prize winner in each category. The Grand Prize winners will then be announced on March 1, 2018.

6. How will winners be notified?

All schools will be notified by phone or email if a student at their school has a winning design. The school will then be responsible for notifying the winning student. Deb will have no direct contact with any student.
